Our 1st-6th grade students would like to help the victims of the earthquake in Haiti. To do this, we are partnering with Faith Evangelical Free Church to fill buckets with necessary items for the Haitian people. Here's the idea: Go to Walmart (or any hardware store), buy a five gallon bucket with a lid, and fill it with supplies! Or, you can buy an item or two and we will fill a bucket for you. How simple, yet what a blessing for the individuals that will receive these gifts!

On February 17th, the buckets will be loaded up and taken to Faith Evangelical Free Church. From there, the buckets will be sent to an organization in Haiti called Double Harvest. A few families from our school have actually been to this mission, so we can attest to their Godly mission work in reaching the Haitian people. They teach the people how to farm, provide jobs, and they have a school and medical clinic/hospital.

As teachers, we are excited about this simple yet worthwhile project to reach these people who have suffered so greatly. Thank you for your consideration in helping us love God's people in Haiti!

Here's a list of necessary items:

Tools:

shovels
picks
work gloves
flashlights
batteries
candles
matches

Clothing:

new flip flops
underwear in packages
t-shirts

Shelter:

plastic table cloths/tarps
sleeping bags
flat sheets (not fitted)
blankets

Food:

dry beans
dry milk
peanut butter (plastic jars)
ketchup (plastic jars)
rice
pasta (bags only)
Energy bars

Other:

band aids
Neosporin
Ace bandages
Motrin/Ibuprofen
Pepto-Bismol
gauze
water purification tablets

Toiletries:

toothpaste
toothbrush
soap
washcloth
baby wipes
