



GROW Green Match Day

Dear FHCS Families,

With your help, we could secure up to \$10,000 in matching funds on GROW GREEN Match Day, April 22, 2019!

The 7th Annual Grow Green Match Day on **Monday, April 22** holds incredible opportunity for Flint Hills Christian School. On that day, the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation will match donations made to our endowment fund—our long-term savings—and we could potentially receive up to a \$10,000 match.

Here's how it works:

- **Come to the event and make a donation.**

Date: Monday, April 22, 2019

Time: 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Place: Colony Square Atrium, 555 Poyntz Avenue

- Online gifts made between 12:00 a.m. – 11:59 p.m. on April 22 will qualify for match dollars. **Please visit growgreenmanhattan.com to make online gifts.**
- Individual contributions to agency endowments ranging from \$25 to \$1,000 per organization will receive a local match at \$.50 per \$1, so a \$1,000 gift will receive a \$500 local match. If a donor gives a \$5,000 gift split evenly between five organizations, each group is eligible to receive a \$500 match.
- The 50% match money can be used by our organization for immediate needs, or we may add it to our endowment. The choice is ours.
- Gifts can be made by cash, check, or online using a credit card. Cash and check gifts should be made in person at the event. Credit card gifts can be made online at **growgreenmanhattan.com** at a remote location, or at the event. **When donating by check, one check must be made payable to the GMCF.** A separate form will be used to indicate which organizations will benefit.
- Gifts made in person at the event at Colony Square will qualify for prize money incentives for Flint Hills Christian School.

I'm asking for you to dig deep, beyond what you give to our annual campaign. Building our endowment is critical for our future, but we still face monthly expenses. So we still need contributions to our annual campaign. Grow Green Match Day is an opportunity to quickly grow our endowment, so that we can enrich our programs for even greater impact, for years to come.
